

1. On the Crucifix

SIGN OF THE CROSS:

In the Name of the Father (touch forehead),
and of the Son (touch heart), and of the
Holy Spirit (touch left, then right shoulder),
Amen

APOSTLES' CREED:

I believe in God, the Father Almighty,
Creator of heaven and earth,
and in Jesus Christ, His only Son, our Lord,
Who was conceived by the Holy Spirit,
born of the Virgin Mary,
suffered under Pontius Pilate,
was crucified, died and was buried;
He descended into hell; on the third day
He rose again from the dead;
He ascended into heaven,
and is seated at the right hand of
God the Father Almighty;
from there He will come
to judge the living and the dead.

I believe in the Holy Spirit,
the holy catholic Church,
the communion of saints,
the forgiveness of sins,
the resurrection of the body,
and life everlasting. Amen.

2. On the Beads

On the Single Bead:

OUR FATHER:

Our Father, Who art in Heaven,
hallowed be Thy name;
Thy Kingdom come, Thy will be done
on earth as it is in Heaven.

Give us this day our daily bread;
and forgive us our trespasses
as we forgive those who trespass against us;
and lead us not into temptation,
but deliver us from evil.

On the Groups of Beads:

HAIL MARY:

Hail Mary, full of grace,
the Lord is with thee.
Blessed art thou amongst women
and blessed is the fruit of thy womb, Jesus.
Holy Mary, Mother of God,
pray for us sinners,
now and at the hour of our death. Amen

NOTE: "You" can replace "thee", and
"Blessed are you among women" can replace
"Blessed art thou amongst women".

3. On the Chain Sections

After the sets of 3 and 10 Hail Mary prayers:

GLORY BE:

Glory be to the Father,
and to the Son,
and to the Holy Spirit.
As it was in the beginning,
is now, and ever shall be,
world without
end.
Amen

After the 10 Hail Mary prayers:

FATIMA PRAYER:

O My Jesus, forgive us our sins,
save us from the fires of hell,
and lead all souls to heaven,
especially those
most in need of Thy mercy.

4. Closing Prayers

HAIL, HOLY QUEEN

Hail, holy Queen, Mother of Mercy,
our life, our sweetness, and our hope.

To thee do we cry,
poor banished children of Eve.

To thee do we send up our sighs,
mourning and weeping in this valley of tears.

Turn then, O most gracious Advocate,
thine eyes of mercy toward us
and after this our exile, show unto us
the blessed fruit of thy womb, Jesus.

O clement, O loving, O sweet Virgin Mary.

*Pray for us, O Holy Mother of God,
That we may be worthy of the promises of Christ.*

THE ROSARY PRAYER:

O God, whose only-begotten Son,
by His life, death and Resurrection,

has purchased for us
the rewards of eternal salvation;
grant, we beseech thee,

that while meditating upon these mysteries
of the most holy Rosary
of the Blessed Virgin Mary,

through the same Christ, our Lord. Amen.

5. The Institution of the Eucharist

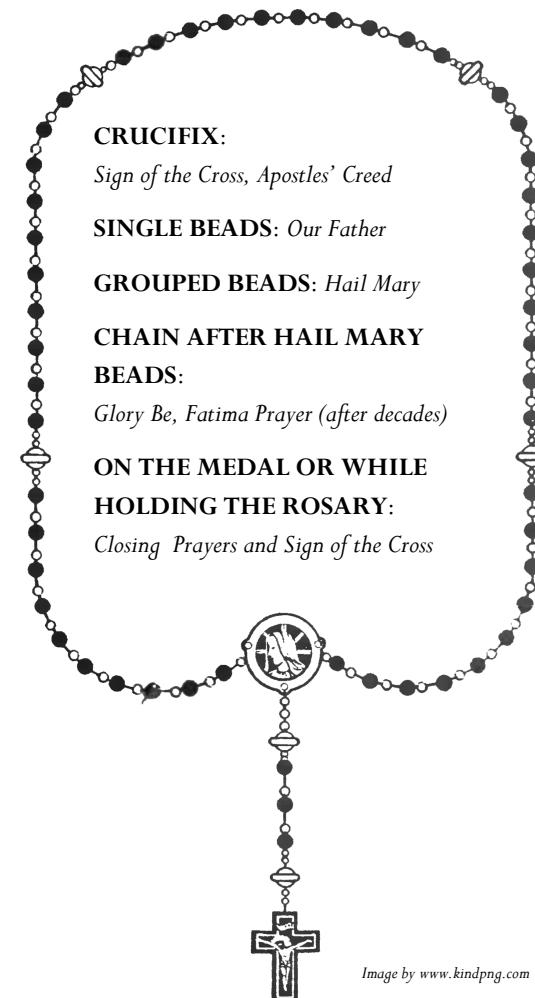
SORROWFUL MYSTERIES (*Tuesdays & Fridays*):
